-	Does the sauna master follow the event guidelines? Timely submission of the theme.		
Opening & Closing		2 Points	
-	Impressions & professionalism of the opening and closing of the infusion. How did the infusion begin? Was there a recognizable conclusion?		
Organi	zation & Hygiene	5 Points	
-	 Are all materials in their designated places? Does the sauna master use a separate towel for themselves? Deductions for: Drying off with the same towel. Whisk towel touching the body. 		
Perfor	nance	5 Points	
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General Deductions:			
- - -	Dropping equipment. Risk from equipment (glass, etc.). Time Overrun: 1 minute = -1 point		

- 2 minutes = -2 points



- More than 2 minutes = Disqualification

- -	Dropping a towel: -0.5 points per instance. Continuing to whisk with a towel that has fallen to the floor: -1 point. Evaluation based on professionalism/organization & hygiene criteria.

Heat Increase & Heat Distribution

General Deductions:

Heat Distribution

- Poor-quality scents (Note: This is not about personal preference).
- Deductions for scents not being perceived as described, scent overuse, or burnt scents.

Heat Increase 9 Points

- Progressive heat increase throughout the infusion rounds. Final round with a clear 'shower' effect. Note: Do guests leave the sauna due to excessive heat?

- Particularly relevant for classic techniques. Heat increase must be perceptible with each technique and impact.

Atmosphere 6 Points

- Each jury member assesses the general atmosphere and audience engagement during the infusion.

Atmosphere & Emotions

- Individual perception of the jury members regarding the infusion, theme, and message.
